Eligibility

This award could be won by developers, layer 1 protocols, gaming platforms, custody solutions, DAOs, interoperability technologies, scalability innovations, privacy and security protocols, DeFi platforms, supply chain solutions, or tokenisation platforms—those driving technological advancements and solving complex challenges.

- Open to businesses from both Australia and internationally, provided international businesses are actively operating within or have a significant business presence in Australia.
- This award is open to businesses that have demonstrated exceptional leadership in the development and deployment of blockchain technology, platforms, and infrastructure.
